



Capital Campaign Update *Commitment Weekend*

Thanks to the generosity of more than 350 parish families, the One Faith, One Community, One Future Capital Campaign has raised over \$4.7 million in pledges and one-time gifts. Combined with parish savings, we now have approximately \$7.2 million toward our \$7.5 million goal for building our new church.

We are very close—but we need the participation of our entire parish family to reach this goal.

This weekend is our **Commitment Weekend**, marking the final phase of our active fundraising effort. At all Masses, every household is invited to complete a pledge card—even if you have already made a pledge or gift. This helps us confirm our collective commitment as a parish.

Matching Gift Opportunity

I am also grateful to share some exciting news:

An anonymous donor has offered to match all **new pledges, increased pledges, and one-time gifts** of any amount made during Commitment Weekend. This means your gift can have twice the impact.

Here are a few examples:

- A family making a new \$30,000 pledge over three years will see their gift matched, resulting in **\$60,000 total**.
- A family increasing their three-year pledge by \$2,000 will have that increase matched, turning it into **\$4,000 in additional support**.
- A family making a one-time gift of \$25,000 will see it matched for a total impact of **\$50,000**.

Every gift—no matter the size—is a sign of faith, unity, and hope for our future.
